Class 1 - 09:00 - Arena 1 - Senior 90cm Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £17.00, Total: £92.00. **Entry Fee = £17.00**

Class 2 - Arena 1 - Bliss of London Novice Winter Championship Qualifier

Rule 316. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

For registered horses in grade C which have not won a total of 125 points, (unless Age Rule applies), to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. Table A7 or Single Phase if more than 50 entries. The first 8 horses qualify for the final, held at the Blue Chip Winter Championships. Qualifiers must jump clear in the first round if A7 or clear in both phases if Single Phase. Qualification does not pass down the line. There will be dual qualification of double clears for the Equissage Pulse Senior British Novice second round (Age rule applies). Please note that in accordance with the amendment to BS Rule 316 all 4yr old horses are now eligible regardless of points won, but to qualify the horse must be 4yrs old in the year of the Final i.e. 2024. Therefore any horses which are 4yrs old from 1st October 2023 to 31st December 2023 and have won more than 125 points are unable to qualify in any qualifiers held from 1st October 2023 to 31st December 2023. Class 3a - Arena 1 - Nupafeed Supplements Senior Discovery - First Round

Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.a) For horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6.b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2018 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6. Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round.Rule 102.16, British Showjumping Hind Boot rule for Boots / Leg Protection applies to this class. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the Senior Discovery Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. If combined with an open:In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the Discovery section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded.In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

Class 3b - Arena 1 - Senior 1.00m Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Prizes: 1st: £40.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £19.00, 5th: £17.00, Total: £121.00. **Entry Fee = £17.00**

Class 4 - Arena 1 - Senior 1.05m Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.05m.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £17.00, Total: £92.00. **Entry Fee = £17.00**

Class 5 - Arena 1 - Senior Newcomers – First Round /1.10m Open

Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- Newcomers:(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6(b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2017, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Newcomers Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6. Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds. Qualifying period: The Senior Newcomers Second Round qualifying period for the 2024 second rounds is 1 May 23 – 30 April 24 (subject to revision). If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. • 1.10m Open:For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £150.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00**

Class 6 - Arena 1 - National 1.15m Members Cup Qualifier

Rule 294. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.15m.

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who are not listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2023. Qualifies for: British Showjumping National

Championships. Qualification period: 1st June-31st May. Numbers to qualify: Two double clears (subject to revision). Qualification is horse/rider combination. If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £150.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00**

Class 7a - Arena 1 - **Senior Foxhunter - First Round**

Rule 310. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. (a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2016, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify. Rule 102.16 British Showjumping hind boot rule for boots/leg protection applies in this class. Qualifies for: The Senior Foxhunter Second Round. Qualifying period: The Senior Foxhunter Second Round qualifying period for 2023/2024 (2024 second rounds and finals) is 1 May '23 - 30 April '24 inclusive. (subject to revision). Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Senior Foxhunter First Round competitions in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money. Horses in the class must go into the jump off and go clear to gain its double clear round qualification. Those horses that have competed in the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2023 are not eligible for qualification to the 2024 Championship. If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Prizes: 1st: £60.00, 2nd: £45.00, 3rd: £35.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £180.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00**

Class 7b - Arena 1 - **Senior 1.20m Open**

Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

Prizes: 1st: £60.00, 2nd: £45.00, 3rd: £35.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £180.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00**
